

Living Expenses in Busan

Transportation:

- Transportation Card: 3000 – 5000 won
- Per trip: Bus – 1130 won | Subway – 1300 won
 - After riding a bus, we can tap our card before leaving the bus for connecting trip. Going from Bus to Bus will be free, Bus to Subway cost 170 won more, Subway to Bus will be free as well.
 - Some students majored in Film may need to go to Centum Campus for classes. They can use School shuttle bus for free. The bus departs from Naengjeong campus every weekday at 8am and 12pm.
- Travel: You can travel from Busan to other cities in Busan using Travel Bus or Train
 - Travel Bus: Most of the time people depart from Sasang Bus Terminal to go to other cities like Seoul or Jinhae. Bus to Seoul costs 24600 won per trip.
 - Train: Train however costs more than Bus especially KTX since KTX travel time is much faster than Bus. KTX to Seoul will cost you 56000 won per trip.

Food:

- Eating out: Cost for eating around campus varies ranging from 3000 won – 6000 won
 - Fancy restaurant in shopping district area may cost more money for around 10000 won – 30000 won per person depends on the kind of the restaurant. But common restaurant usually cost around 6000 won – 10000 won per meal.
 - Bread store like Tous les Jours
 - or Paris Baguette cost around 1000 – 5000 won per item.
- Cooking: Obviously groceries cost cheaper than eating out. Here's some of the prices:
 - Chicken – 5500 won / chicken
 - Beef – 2385 won / 100gr
 - Rice – 5625 won / 1kg
 - Banana – 4600 won / 1kg
 - Onion – 1860 won / 1kg

Drinks:

- Any restaurants provide free water for the customers so you will find water easily.
- Soft drinks however cost more
 - Coca cola (Soda) – 1000 – 2000 won / 1.25L
 - Juice – 1000 – 2000 won / 2L
 - Milk – 1500 – 2500 won / 1L

Dormitory:

- Semester – 530,000 won for whole semester period (4 Months). (GV)
- Vacation – 400,000 won for whole vacation period (2 and a half Months).

Entertainment:

- Movie:
 - CGV – 8000 – 10000 won / movie
 - Lotte Cinema – 9000 – 11000 won / movie
 - Megabox – 7000 – 9000 won / movie

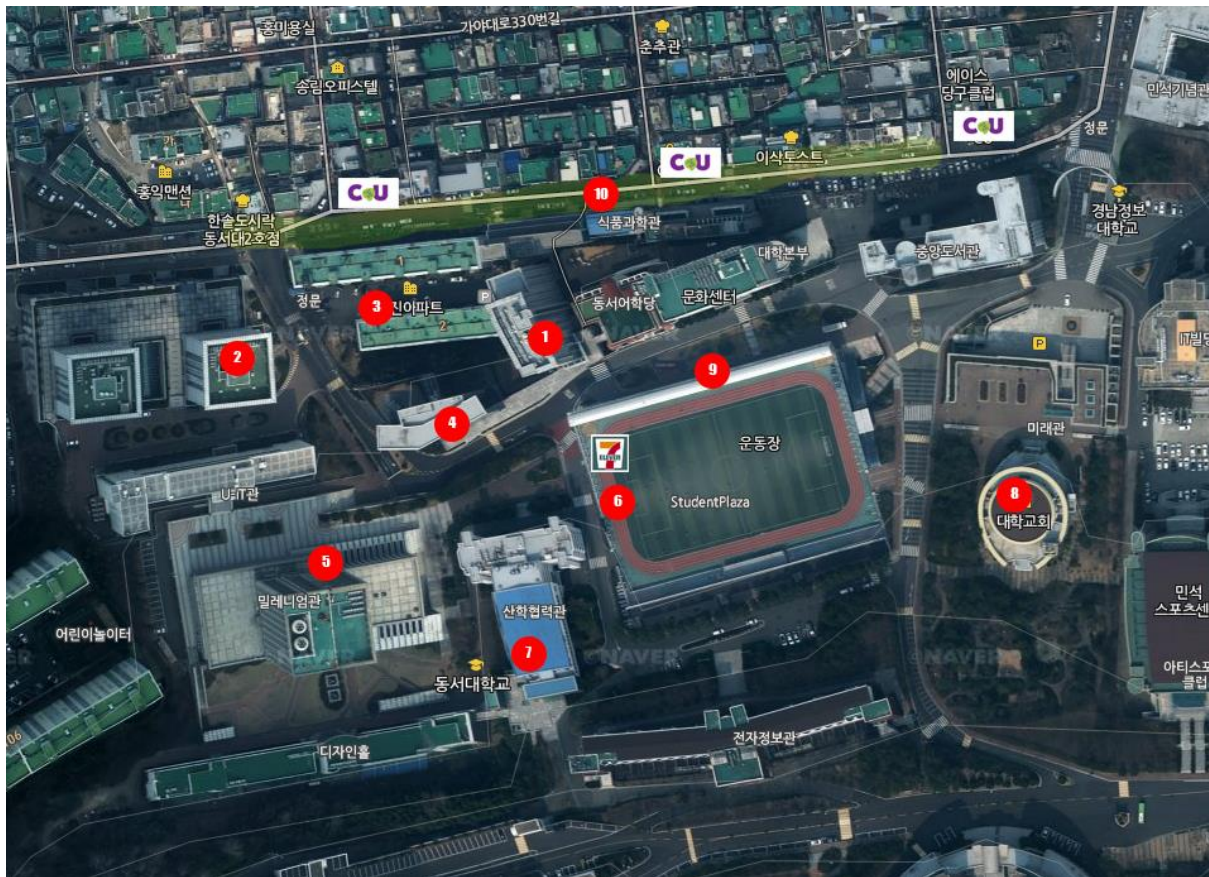
Telecommunication

- Phone: Student may register for a new sim card for their mobile phone. Student should be 20 years or older in order to be able to register for the sim card.
 - Monthly Plan (Post Paid)
 - Pre-Paid
- Portable Wi-Fi: Students may register for a Monthly-Paid Portable Wi-Fi. The quota for this portable Wi-Fi varies depending on the plan. 11 GB plan will cost 14000 won per month and the payment will be paid through the debit card. The bank will automatically deduct your balance each month.

 - Frying Pan – 2000 – 10000 won / unit
 - Cup and Plate – 1000+ won each

 - Notebook – 1000 – 3000 won each

 - Journal / Planner – 4000 – 8000 won each
