<Periodic Health Checkup> *Required

The School Health and Safety Act requires students to undergo a medical checkup once a year.

The implementation period differs between campuses.

- Bunkyo Campus:
April (current students), June (new students/ transfer students)
- Matsuoka Campus: April to May
- Tsuruga Campus: Mid-April

Details will be announced at a later date on the Student Portal, the Health Service Center website, and on-campus bulletin boards.

Medical Certificate cannot be issued without taking a periodic medical checkup.
